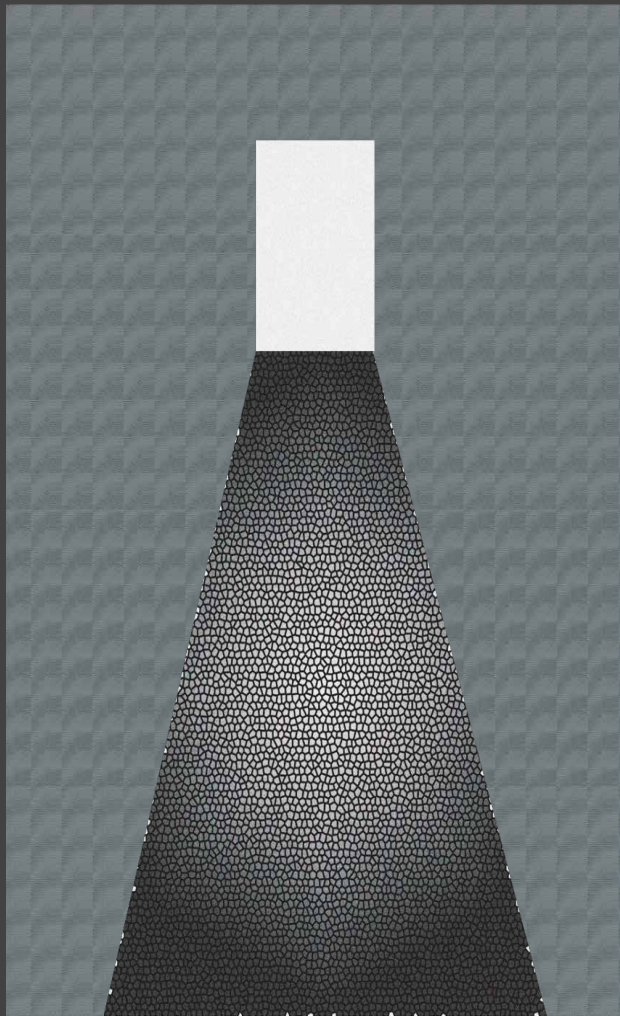
Texture is the tactile grain of surfaces and substances.

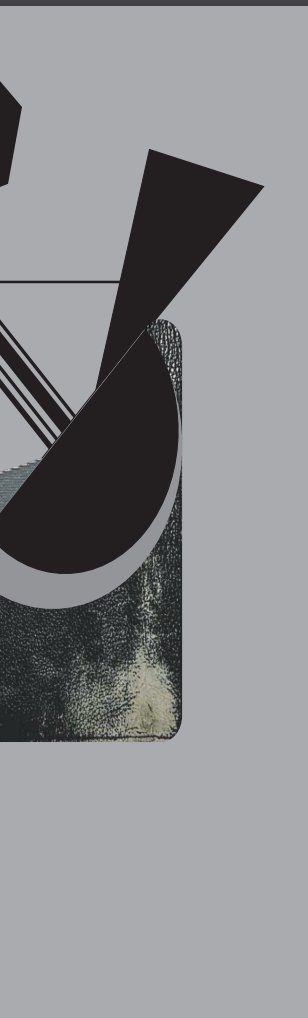
If you touch something (it is likely) someone will feel it.
